

THE SUNDAY PAPER Year C Epiphany

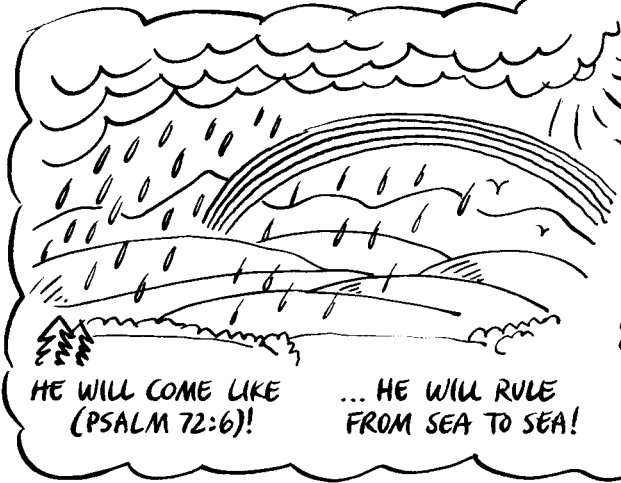
