What you can expect going forward will be like this:

- the first page will be an article from Rob or Alison (as usual)
- we will have birthdays and anniversaries and other transitions, as well as photos of members. In addition, you will see a more indepth "Getting to Know You" article on some new members.
- As we increase our sense of belonging and connection with each other, you will read answers from members about 'Why I Love?' certain parts of our common life.
